8. Ethical Practice & Professional Responsibility – Values-based leadership, mindfulness, and ethical decision-making.

9. Innovation, Leadership & Continuous Growth – Leadership development, systems thinking, and future-focused education.

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Description

The Academy of Universal Metaphysics (AUM) is hosting the **International Holistic Education Conference Las Vegas 2026**. It is a 3-day conference March 27-29, 2026, for the general public to participate in Las Vegas, Nevada, USA, offering 15 PD credit hours. This is a significant event for educators and leaders of innovation, specifically, on how to best nurture the present and future youth. AUM supports and prepares them for the real world; while experiencing and discovering various career fields they may best implement their talents towards. 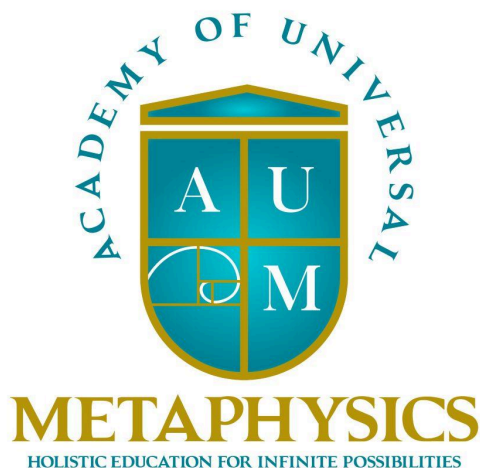
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Outcome Deliverables:

The conference will generate tangible products in order to make progress towards the proposed outcomes. Below is a list of possible outputs this event may produce:

- 1) A Letter to My Future Self: Based on what they learned by the end of the conference, participants will be asked to write a letter to themselves 5 years into the future as an opportunity for introspection and goal setting.
- 2) Portfolio—physical & digital: Every presenter will be asked to provide a tangible item related to their presentation for the attendees to take home in their portfolio. These may be business pamphlets, an excerpt from a book, a craft, or even a worksheet that provides strategies for stress management, mindfulness and emotional awareness.
- 3) Digital Take Home: Example, a 3-5 minute highlight video filmed throughout the conference and shown during the closing ceremony. Everyone will have access to this video of introspection, recap, and reflection to download or have access to within AumEvents.org or AumNevada.org.
